A Note from your Newburgh SHIP office

Did you know there's no need to drive to the local Social Security office to apply for Medicare benefits? It's true; you can use Social Security's online application to sign up for Medicare. In most cases, once your application is submitted online you are done. You can use the online Medicare application if you:

- Are at least 64 years and 9 months old
- Want to sign up for Medicare but do not currently have **ANY** Medicare coverage, and
- Do not want to start receiving Social Security benefits at this time. (If you aren't sure, you can apply for Medicare now and apply online for benefits later).
- **Note:** If you have a Health Savings Account (HSA) and/or health insurance based on employment, you may want to ask your personnel office or insurance company how signing up for Medicare will affect you.

If you have any questions pertaining to Medicare or other related issues, feel free to call your local SHIP office.
