Valentine's Day Red Velvet Hot Chocolate

Have a happy Valentine's Day! For a special treat, try making Red Velvet Hot Chocolate. It's a beautiful hug in a mug!

Ingredients

- 1 cup heavy whipping cream
- ¼ cup white chocolate chips
- 1 teaspoon vanilla extract
- 1 packet of instant hot chocolate mix
- Red food coloring
- Whipped cream and red sprinkles for garnish

Instructions

1. In a medium sauce pan heat the milk and cream over medium heat and whisk in white chocolate chips.
2. Stir until melted. Add the hot chocolate mix and stir on low for a few minutes.
3. Stir in the vanilla extract and a couple drops of red food coloring.



4. Pour into a mug and top with whipped cream and red sprinkles.
